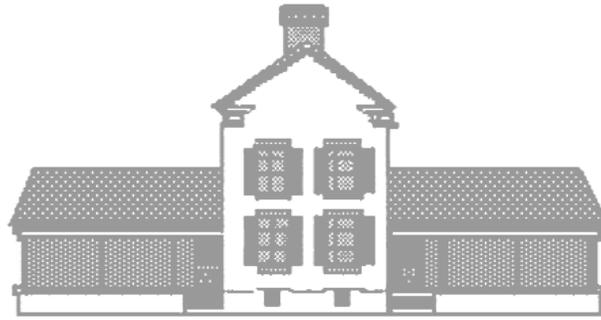

# Think Spring!


