Historic District

This is a friendly reminder that the Prospect Hill neighborhood houses two local historic districts each with certain design guidelines for exterior work. Exterior work may require a Certificate of Appropriateness (COA) permit from the Historic Preservation Commission or Staff in Housing and Neighborhood Development. There is no fee to apply for a COA. A few photographs, plans, a map and a description of the work area is all you need. A COA is much like a building permit. It should be displayed in your window while work is in progress. Grants may be available to help. If you have questions about whether your work requires review please contact the historic preservation program manager at 812-349-3507.
